

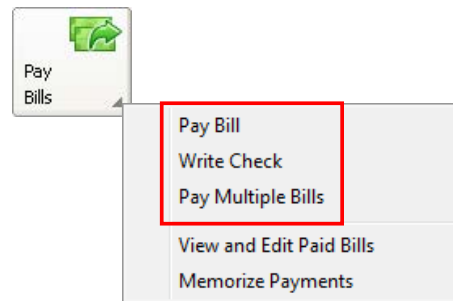
Paying Bills

Quick Reference Guide

How do I pay my vendors?

Go to the **Vendor & Purchases Navigation Center** and select Pay Bills. There are different payment options that you can choose, such as Pay Bill, Write Check, or Pay Multiple Bills.



Which payment option should I choose?

- Use **Pay Bill** to:
 - Pay a vendor bill/invoice
 - Enter prepayments
 - Update job cost expenses

Note: When you select Pay Bill the Payments window opens.

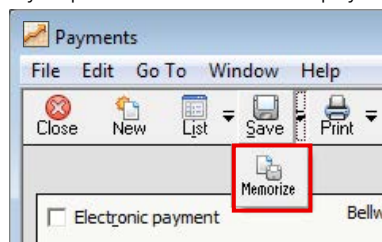
- Use **Pay Multiple Bills/Select for Payment** to:
 - Pay multiple vendor bills/invoices at once

Note: If you have multiple invoices from one vendor, only one check is created for the total of the invoices. Check Pay for the invoices you want to include and click Print.

- Use **Write Checks** if:
 - You want to enter and print a quick check without having to enter individual line items.
 - You are not paying a bill/ invoice
 - You do not need to pay for inventory items received or to update job costing expenses.

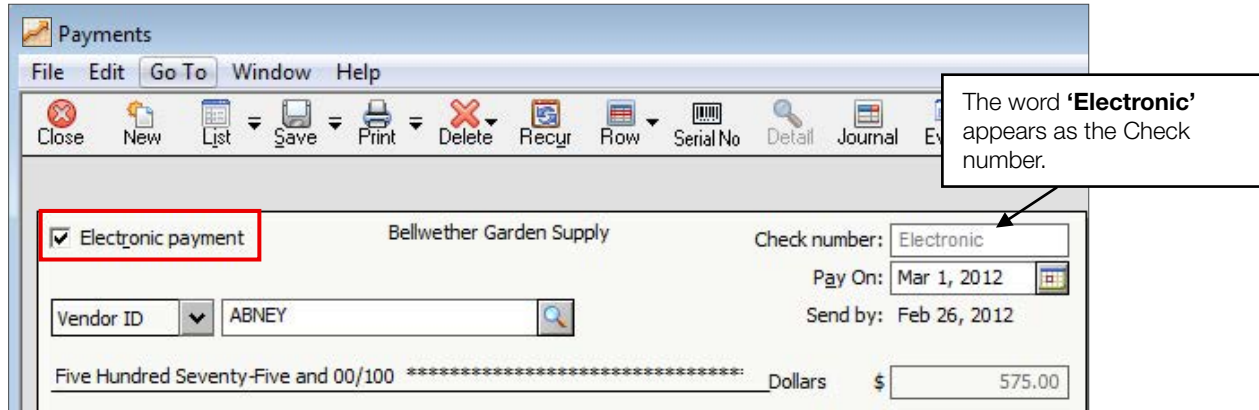
Did you know?

- If you plan to create the same payment in the future, you can save it as a memorized transaction.
