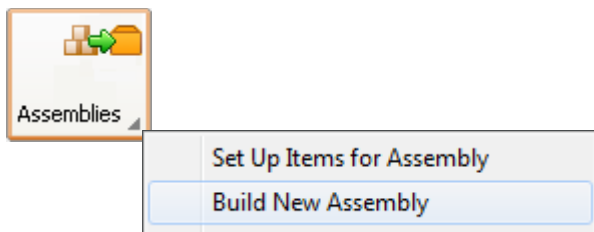
Quick Reference Guide

What is an assembly?

An assembly consists of two or more inventory items that are grouped together and sold as one unit. You can build or unbuild the components (Bill of Materials) of an assembly.

How do I build or unbuild an assembly?

Go to the **Inventory & Services Navigation Center** > Assemblies > Build New Assembly.



Select the assembly Item ID in the Build/Unbuild Assembly window. Enter the quantity you would like to build or unbuild. The components used in the assembly are displayed at the bottom of the window.
