

# A new way to get paid with Invoice Payments

Sage has partnered with **Stripe** and **PayPal** to bring you the latest feature, Invoice Payments, in Sage 50 Accounting. You will be able to invoice your customers by email and include a Pay Now button that your customers can use to pay you with a card. Payments are securely processed online and deposited directly to your bank account. If you currently use Sage 50 and have a Business Care Plan, you can activate this feature today!

## How it works:

1. Connect to Invoice Payments.
2. Select a payment service provider.
3. Set up your company to accept online payments.
4. Send invoices to your customers through email on the transaction window so they can pay online.
5. Receive customer payment. Your records are updated automatically.

**Note:** Internet access is required to use Invoice Payments.

## Connect to Invoice Payments

To include a Pay Now button in invoices you send to your customers through email, you need to connect to Invoice Payments, select a payment service, and set up your company to receive the payments.

### How to setup:

1. In the Home window on the Setup menu, choose **Settings**.
2. Under Customers & Sales, click **Invoice Payments**.
3. Click **Set Up Payment Service**.
4. Provide a primary email address that can be used to set up a new account with the payment service.
5. Agree to the Terms and Conditions and click **Get Started**.
6. Select the Payment Service you want to use (Stripe or PayPal) and click **Connect**.
7. Close the window.
8. Select linked accounts to keep track of the online payments and the fees you pay to use the payment service

**Note:** If the payment service requires more information or has other tasks to complete account setup, check the email that you used when selecting the payment service.

**Tip:** As payment services become available, you can add them. To add a payment service, click Manager Service to open the Invoice Payments window.
