Start of a journey

Cantiro Group Companies is a fully integrated real estate development firm operating in Alberta, Ontario and British Columbia. With a focus on single-family homes, communities, and commercial properties, Cantiro manages over \$500 million in assets.

For years, Cantiro relied on Sage 300 Construction and Real Estate, which served them well as an accounting system. However, they began encountering challenges that made them rethink their approach.
