Registration

Q: What does my registration include?

A: Full conference registration includes access to keynotes, sessions, lunches, refreshments, cocktail events, Sage Expo Centre, Gala dinner and awards ceremony

Q: Where do I check-in to get my event badge?

A: Sage Summit Tour will be at the Sandton Convention Centre, 161 Maude Street, Sandton

Q: Will I be able to park at Sandton Convention Centre and will my parking ticket be reimbursed?

A: Yes, there is ample parking at Sandton Convention Centre and parking tickets will be issued at the registration desk at the end of each day.

Q: Will Wi-Fi be available?

A: Yes, there will be complimentary wireless internet access available throughout the main areas of the event within the convention centre.
