### **Future of Work**

'Future of Work' forms the backbone of our global programmes by building routes into education, employment and entrepreneurship for young people, women and military veterans. We look to ensure all participants of these programmes achieve work readiness and that a bright and prosperous future is attainable for all. These programmes include:

- Sage Pathways: developing alternative pathways to employment at Sage.
- Sage Work Experience: helping young people to develop skills for work readiness and providing potential employment opportunities at Sage.
- Sage FutureMakers: teaching young people how artificial intelligence can be used for good.
- Sage Enterprise Tycoon: empowering students aged 6 to 18 to understand the fundamentals of business planning, trading and competition.
- Sage Military Tycoon: transforming the lives of military veterans, providing them with entrepreneurial skills to launch their own business

# **Impact Evaluation**

Over the past five years we have given back over 110,000 volunteer days to non-profits who support our communities, totalling £14,784,000 in volunteer time across 22 markets. We have provided over 650 grants to non-profits serving military veterans, women and young people and over 1,800 non-profits have benefited from discounted Sage Business Cloud product subscriptions.

Sage colleagues, partners and customers have raised more than \$2 million for charities in our local markets.
